Carpool participants may opt to use the vehicle of the permit holder or any other rider's parking permit. If the vehicle of the rider is used and rider does not own a University of Miami parking permit, the following two criteria must be met: 1. The rider's vehicle must be registered to the permit holder's account in the University of Miami parking system (visit the Parking Office to register rider's vehicle).				
 Both the permit holder and rider must be present in the vehicle when driving to the campus with the RIdeFlag App in use to record the carpool. Parking upgrades NOT AVAILABLE in Restricted, Reserved, Service, and Visitor color zones RideFlag App is the university's official Carpool App. All carpool participants must verify their carpool using the RideFlag App. Failure to follow these procedures may result in a 				
\$750 fraudulent permit fine and the referral to the Dean of Students and/or HR for disciplinary procedures.				
All carpool participants must sign this form. A signature denotes you have read and agree to abide by the Parking Policies and Procedures. Your signature further confirms your understanding that parking at the University of Miami is a privilege and may be suspended or revoked for any violation(s) of the Parking Policies.				
The Emergency Ride Home vouchers assures alternative transportation users that they will not be stranded on campus in the event of an unexpected personal emergency. As a Carpool participant, you must register with South Florida Commuter Services for the ERH program, and your registration will remain effective for the duration of your employment or enrollment at UM.
